Dear Wife:

We are now loading the Boat
to leave for Tennessee, and I will not have
an opportunity of seeing you before I go
I cannot leave without, causing a difficulty
and therefore I will go but will not be
gone very long before I return perhaps
to remain; I want you to send my
socks, shirts and drawers to Mr. Lane
and he will bring them to me
when he comes on. He has been left to
the sick. I hope that you will
reconcile yourself to your fate.
