## INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

THE FLORIDA ANTHROPOLOGIST publishes original papers in all subfields of anthropology with an emphasis on archaeology. Contributions from allied disciplines are acceptable when concerned with anthropological problems. The journal's geographical scope, in order of importance, includes Florida, Southeastern United States, Caribbean, and related regions.

Manuscripts should be double spaced and typed on one side only of an 8 1/2 by 11 inch sheet leaving at least a 1 inch margin on all sides. Contributors are referred to American Antiquity and the Chicago Manual of Style for matters of style and reference. Textual references should be similar to "Smith 1964: 78-80; Jones 1969: Pl. II, b." No footnotes. In the "Reference Cited" section, at the end of an article, do not abbreviate names of series or journals. Books need full title, publisher's name, and place.

All illustrative material—line drawings (in India ink) and photographs—should be included in one numbered series of "Figures" suitable for a maximum reduction to 6 1/2 by 8 1/2 inches. Parts of figures are designated by lower case letters. Figures must be accompanied by brief descriptive captions. All tabular material must be included in separately numbered "Tables."

Twenty-five reprints without covers of each article are furnished free to each author or group of authors. Additional copies, with or without covers, may be purchased but the editor must be informed of the number desired when the article is offered for publication.
